GOALS

- Improve collaboration between the three partners
- Focus on housing as a method to preserve families and to provide key services
- Enhance local dialogue on need for preventative services for families at risk of or currently involved in child welfare system
- Expand services and support for families moving into Gonzaga Family Haven and prioritize families involved with child welfare
- Community focused on aligning outcomes, using data and storytelling

HOUSING

This site includes a single site housing complex, Gonzaga Family Haven (75 units), and scattered site housing. Funding includes Family Unification Program Housing Vouchers and multiple resources from the State of Washington for services, including foundational community supports, which is housing support services funded by Medicaid.

WHAT'S DIFFERENT

- Enhanced coordination among partners resulting in increased referrals for FUP vouchers
- Earlier referrals from Washington State Department of Children, Youth & Families (DCYF) to Catholic Charities Eastern Washington (CCEW) for supportive and preventative services
- Creation & launch of Housing Resource tool tailored for child protection workers
- Whole-family, whole-health services and support model
